Our goal is to schedule those that have volunteered in the past first, then open the volunteering up to others that want to assist us in making our event the amazing festival that it is.

This year, we will have shifts available beginning Wednesday, August 23rd at 8am through to Saturday, August 26th evening. As a volunteer, you will receive the following for working at the event:

1 x 4 hours shift = Weekend Pass for \$75

2 x 4 hours shift = Weekend Pass for free

All volunteers will receive a new t-shirt to wear during their shift that you can keep - as our thanks to you!

LMITF Job Descriptions*

1. Traffic Control:

- Welcome guests and assist in directing traffic flow in and out of the festival
- Ensuring arrivals in cars and on foot have necessary tickets/wristbands
- Must be mature, courteous yet assertive
- Must be able to stand for duration of shift.

HOURS: Wednesday, August 23 through until Saturday, August 26

2. Camping:

- Assist at camping registration as campers arrive
- May need to aid in directing trailers, distributing wristbands, scanning tickets
- Must be quick and courteous and be on feet for duration of their shift

HOURS: Wednesday, August 23 through until Saturday, August 26

3. Bar:

- May be serving alcohol, stocking bar supplies, applying wristbands, assisting with crowd control, selling drink tickets
- MUST have SMART SERVE (will need to provide certificate) and be at least 25 years of age
- Limited positions

HOURS: Thursday August 24, Friday August 25, Saturday August 26 – afternoon and mostly evenings

4. Hospitality Tent – Lost & Found, Information, Ice Sales

- Log found items, help those that have lost items
- Sell ice to campers throughout the weekend
- Provide information to attendees on the festival itself, Lucknow and surrounding area as needed
- Check wristbands for those entering the concert area

HOURS: Thursday, August 24 through until Saturday, August 26

5. Ticket/Will Call Booth

- Scan tickets and apply wristbands
- Sell tickets (if not sold out)
- Monitor entrances into festival to ensure people have ticket or wristband

HOURS: Thursday August 24, Friday August 25, Saturday August 26 – afternoon and evenings

*Not all positions and shifts available to everyone. All shifts to be approved by LMITF.
